RCA Proposes Town Status for Reston

Reston residents cast their votes for Reston Citizens Association (RCA) Board members at the Reston Festival July 9-10 and signed

a petition and/or took a straw poll on whether the VA legislature should be asked to authorize a referendum on Reston incorporating and becoming a town. (Sue Merk, an Edgewater resident was elected as an At-Large Board member and is also the RCA Webmaster.) Of the 150 responding to the poll, the margin of those in favor of Reston Town Governance was almost 2 to 1 and over 300 signed the petition. RCA held meetings in June to present information on their proposal and has extensive coverage on their website at: <http://restoncitiensassociation.org>

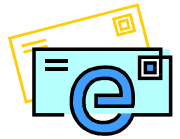
